
Add Additional Sensors

You can add more than one sensor to your AbiBird account – perhaps you want to monitor more than one room in your cared-for person’s home.

To add additional sensors to your AbiBird account, you need to:

1. Access sensors menu
2. Add a sensor
3. Pair sensor with app and account
4. Name sensor location and place in position
5. Set up daily routines

Step 1: Access ‘Sensors’ menu



Login to AbiBird with your username (email) and password.
The *Sensors* menu will open.

NOTE: If you are already in the AbiBird app you can access the *Sensors* menu by selecting the **Sensors** icon (bottom left).






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
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Step 2: Add sensor




On the *Sensors* menu, select the + icon (top right).
The *Let's connect your sensor* page will open.

Step 3: Pair sensor with app and account



To pair the sensor with your app and account, follow the steps in the guide: [How to Pair AbiBird Sensor with App and Account](#).

Step 4: Name sensor location and place in position



Once you have paired the sensor with the app and your account, you can name its location and place it in position.

To name the sensor's location and position it in the room you want to monitor, follow the steps in the guide: [How to Name Sensor Location and Place in Position](#).




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
Step 5: Set up daily routines



Once you have named the sensor's location and placed it in position, you can set up the expected daily routines for the room.

Working in the app, you have:

- Accessed the sensors menu
- Added another sensor
- Paired the sensor and app
- Set daily routines for the sensor

NOTE

You don't set notification preferences for each sensor. Notification preferences apply to all sensors paired to your AbiBird account. However, you can pause notifications for a particular sensor (see guide: [How to Pause Sensor Notifications](#)).
